Solar, Safety and Security Window Films: Technical Information Sheet

Australian Automotive Tinting Regulations

No film (including clear) is allowed on any windscreen except for a 'visor strip' no wider than 10% down the window or to the top of the arc made by the windscreen wipers, whichever is the lesser amount.

Reflective films are illegal in all parts of Australia. All Solar Gard® automotive films are within the legal permissible limits for visible light reflection.

These refer to the total visible light transmission of glass and film.
